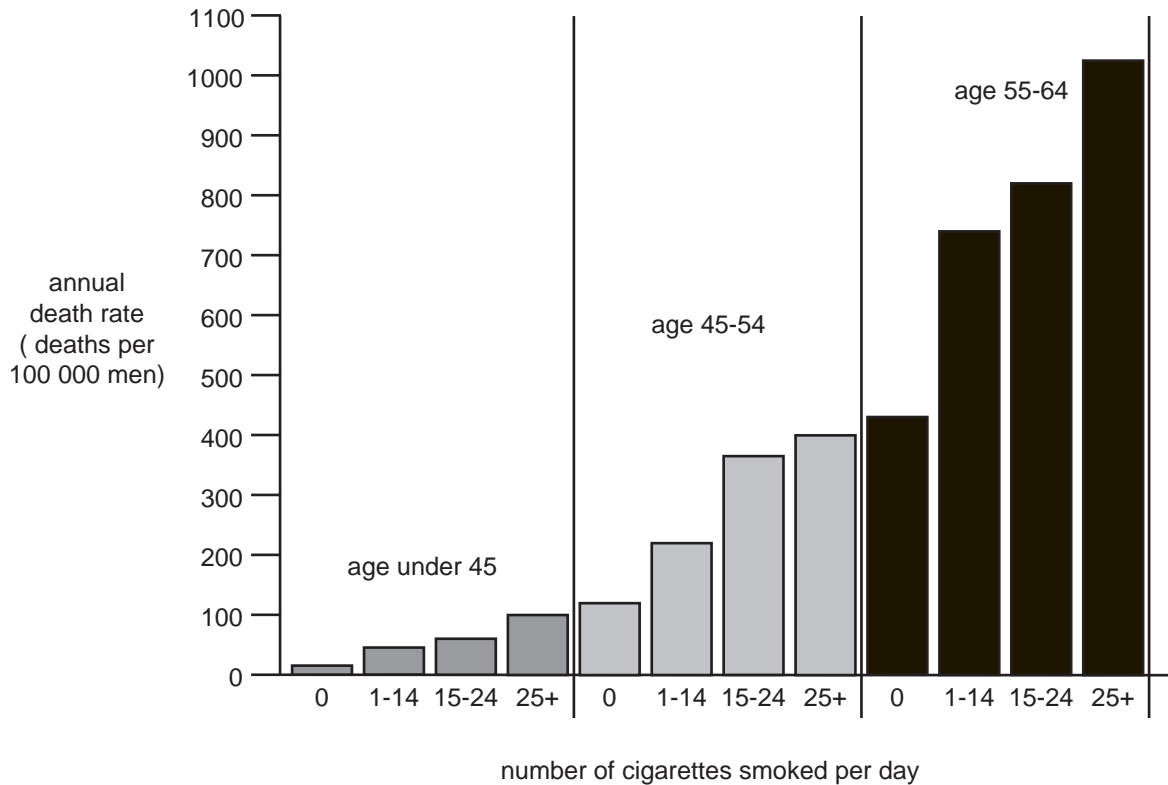


Smoking

- a) the death rate of men aged 45-54 who smoke more than 25 cigarettes a day is higher than the death rate for non-smokers in the same age range. How much is it higher?

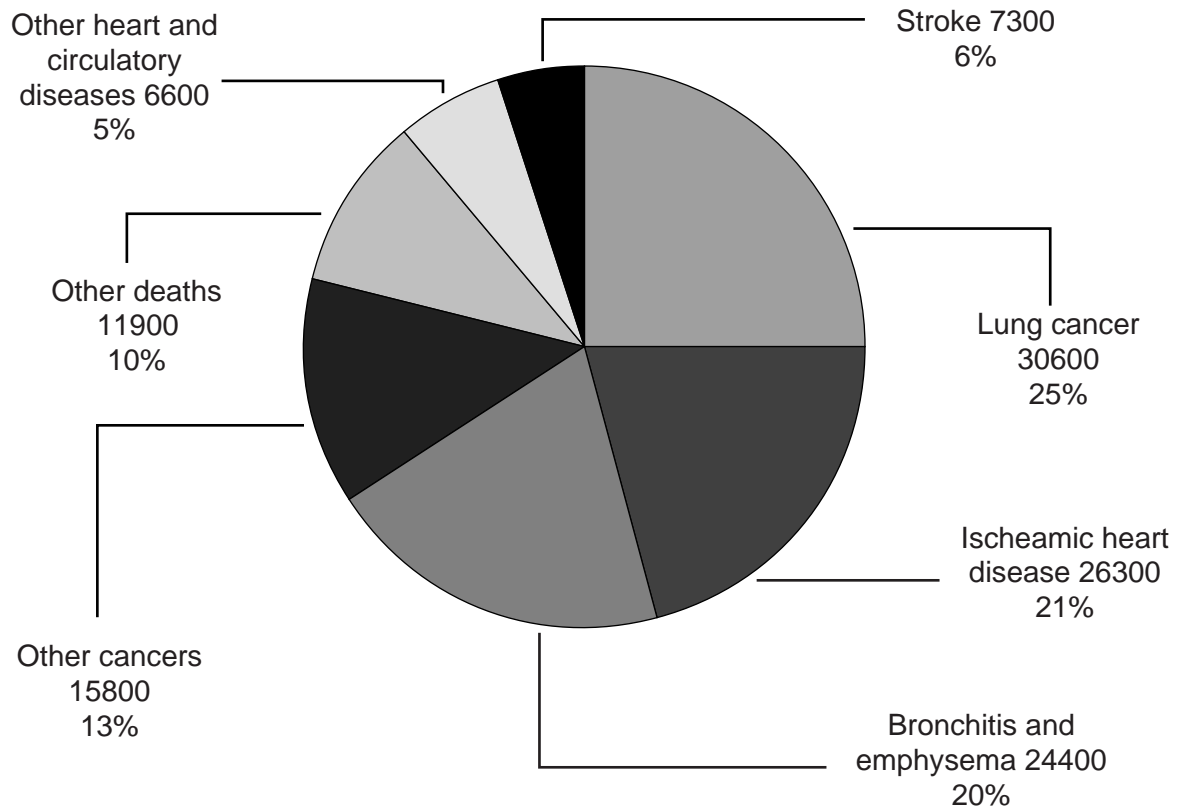
- b) Explain, as fully as you can, why the death rate for smokers is higher than the death rate for non-smokers in each age group.
